

Trudeau's High Tax, Big Government Agenda Will Hurt Working Canadians

Ottawa, May 25, 2015 — Working Canadians today launched radio ads highlighting Liberal leader Justin Trudeau's inability to relate to and stand up for ordinary working Canadians.

"We are very concerned about Trudeau's consistent opposition to tax cuts and direct benefits for middle class families and seniors," said Catherine Swift, Working Canadians' spokesperson. "Trudeau appears to have no understanding of the challenges that working Canadians face every day just to make ends meet."

Trudeau voted against the Home Renovation Tax Credit, First Time Home Buyers' Tax Credit, a tax credit to take care of elderly and sick relatives, and a children's art tax credit, to name a few. Recently, Trudeau vowed to repeal the Universal Child Care Benefit and compel the provinces to impose a carbon tax, as well as roll back the Tax Free Savings Account (TFSA) limit to \$5,500 from \$10,000 per annum.

"Unfortunately, Mr. Trudeau seems determined to pursue a high-tax, big-government agenda – an approach that has failed wherever it has been tried around the world. These policies are also those promoted by labour unions, at the expense of the majority of Canadians who don't belong to a union and don't want to belong to a union. We have seen what these union-friendly policies have done in Ontario with massive deficits, growing debt, businesses fleeing the province and sluggish job creation. The last thing we need is to extend this failed approach across Canada," Swift added.

"At this time of global economic uncertainty, allowing Canadians to keep more of their hard-earned money is the right thing to do to promote consumer and business confidence. Governments currently take about half of Canadians' income, and much of those funds are spent wastefully. Increasing that burden further and expanding government even more is the wrong way to go," said Swift.
