

WORKING CANADIANS PUTS POLICE PAY RAISES IN LINE OF FIRE

December 9, 2013—Just two weeks into our public debut, Working Canadians is getting results when it comes to shedding light on union influence on government.

In an interview on a London radio station, we exposed the fact that Ontario is the only province where police chiefs have no discretion over pay. We're the only organization raising awareness of the enormous political power 17,000 unionized police officers have over politicians and the consequences this has on municipal budgets.

As a direct result of Working Canadians' interview, four London councillors are now pledging to support a motion for a zero percent increase in the police budget, and an active campaign has started for this motion.

We kept up our momentum with a kick off lunch headlined by our spokeswoman, Catherine Swift, in London. The response from the 240 attendees was overwhelmingly positive.

Working Canadians has now launched an active fundraising campaign for more events and advertising, so we can keep raising awareness that the demands union bosses make are driving up taxes, debt and deficit.
